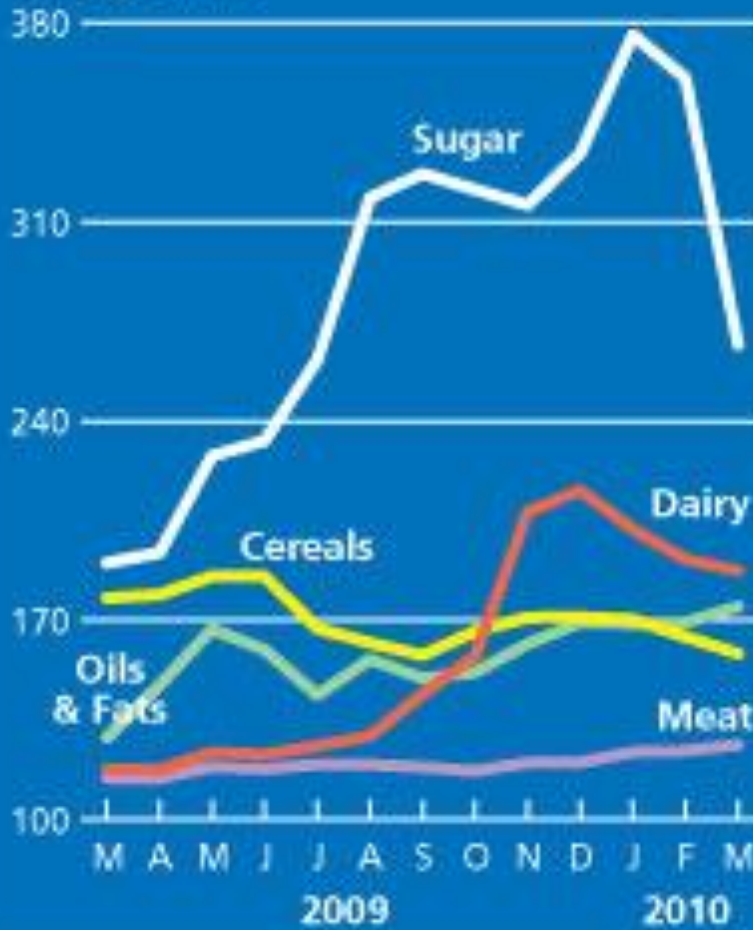
# FAO Food Price Index

2002-2004=100

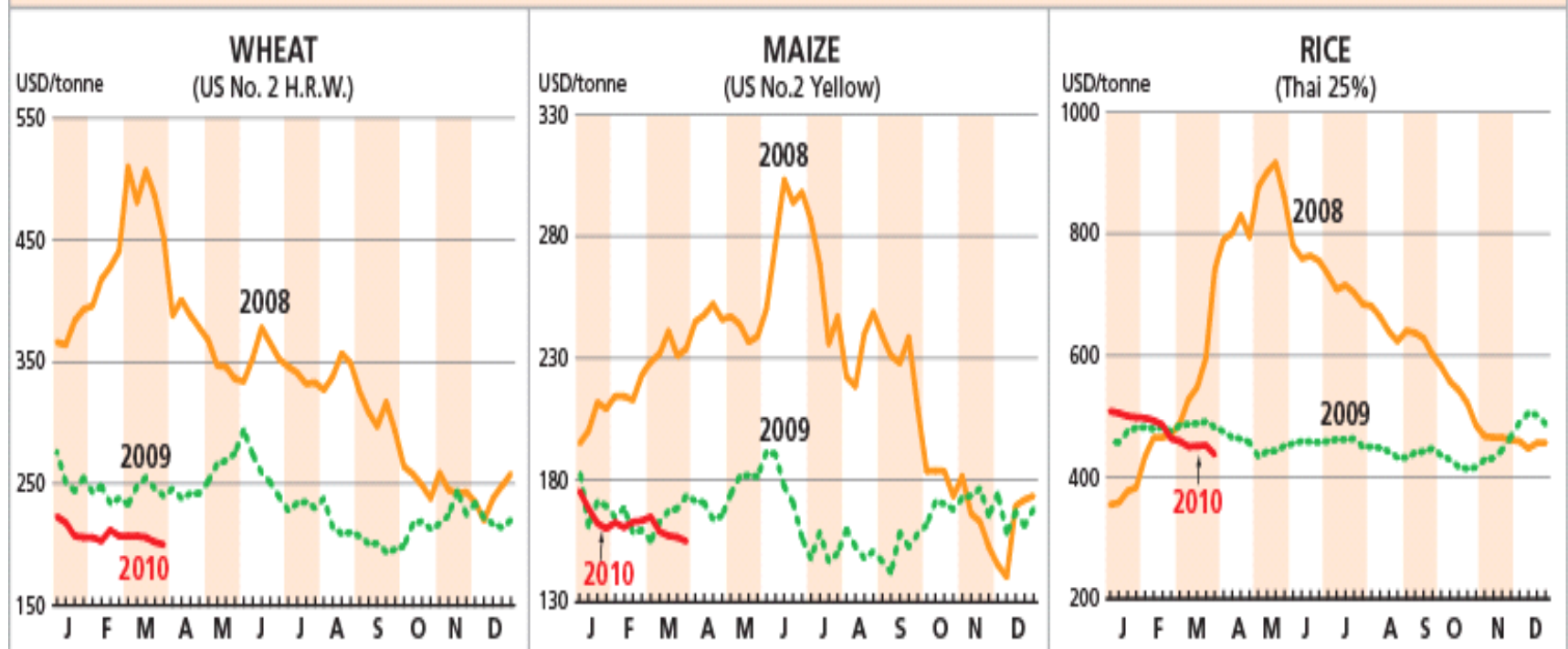


# Food Commodity Price Indices

2002-2004=100

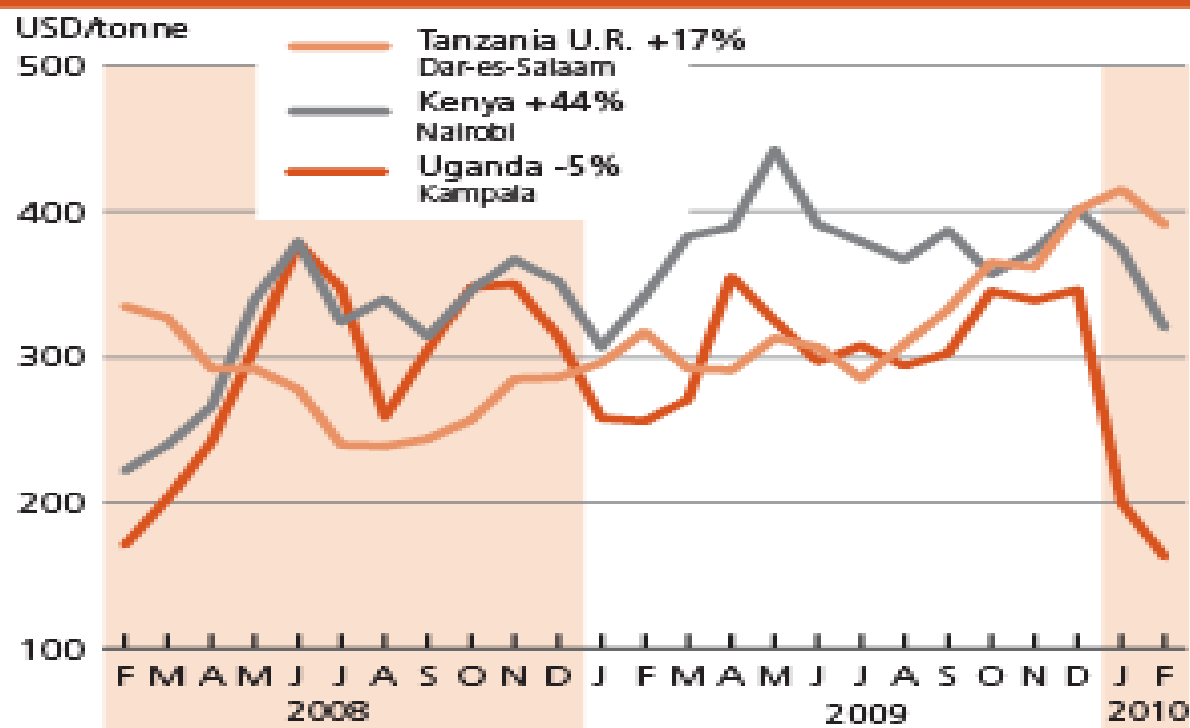


## Weekly Quotations of Cereal Export Prices (2008-2010)

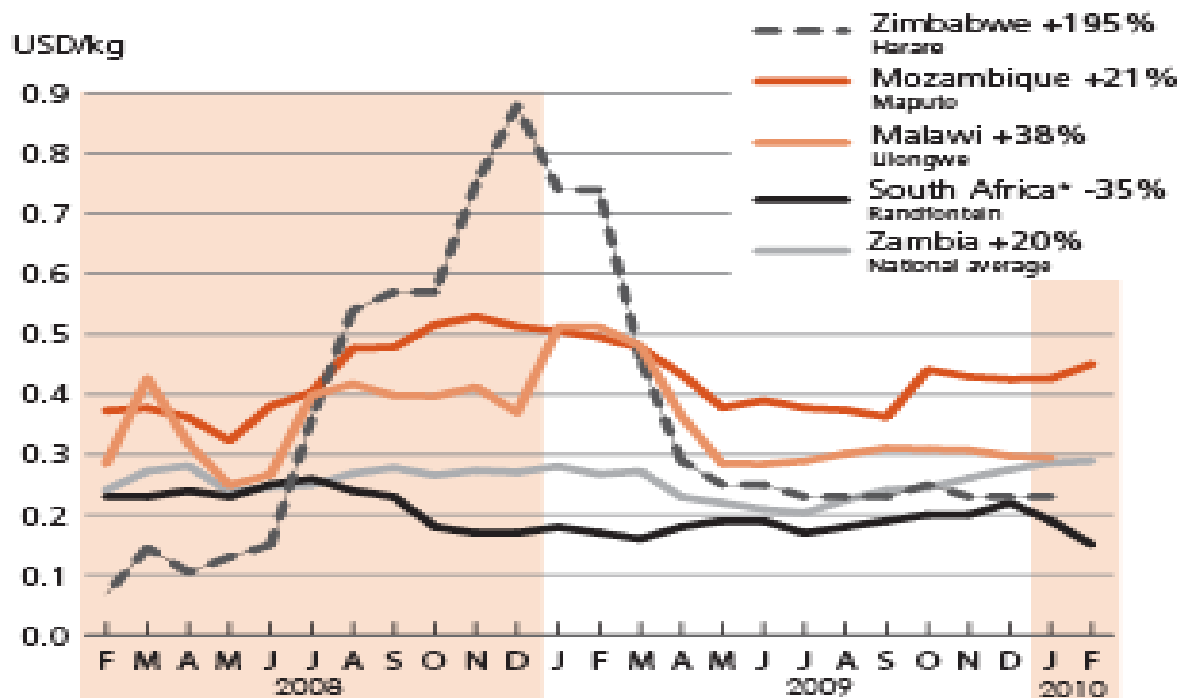
## Maize prices in selected Eastern African markets

## White maize prices in selected Southern African markets



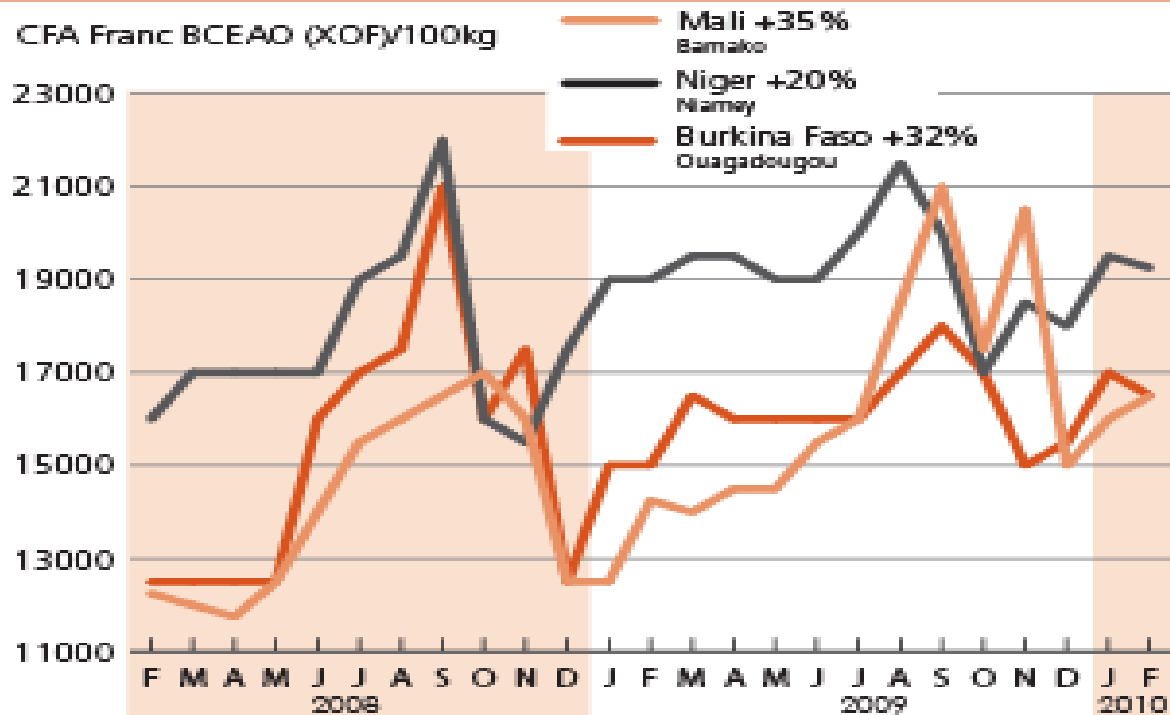

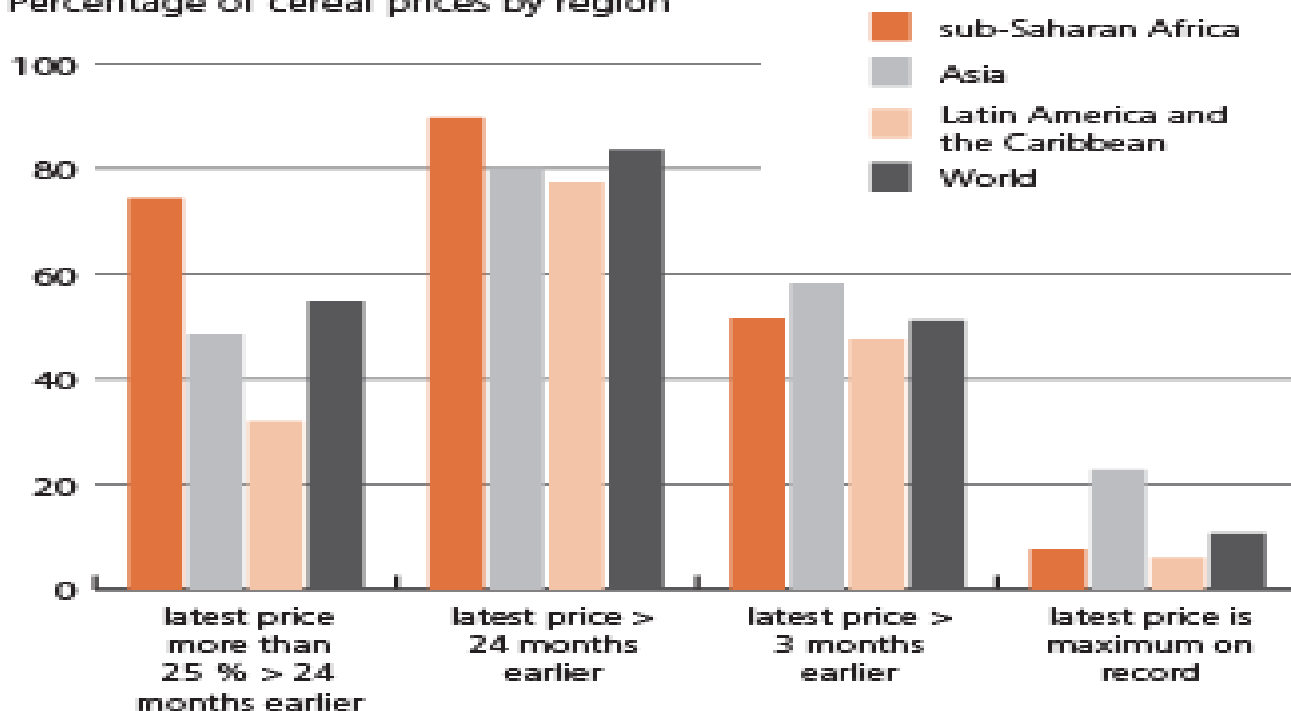

# Analysis

## National cereal prices

Prices of staple food cereals in developing countries generally remain well above the pre-crisis levels of early 2008, although down from their peaks reflecting the good 2009 cereal harvest and lower international export prices.
